Under "Basic Monitoring / Commands" you can see an overview of all commands. In the header there are four tabs (Commands, Host checks, Notifications and Event handler) and two buttons.

Filter Offers the ability to filter the command list by name.

New command:

There are two buttons in the header of the input form used for creating a new time period.

\$ Macros overview Displays an overview of all user-defined macros. These can be created and edited under "Expert Monitoring / User-defined Macros".

Field name	Required Field	Description
Command type	⚠	Type of command (service check, host check, notification or event handler)
Name	⚠	The name of the command
Command line		The actual command to be executed
Description		The description of the command
